

2012-2013 Presidential Scholarship Application

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

FEBRUARY 20, 2012

Each year, a select number of outstanding incoming freshmen receive Macon State College Foundation Presidential Scholarships, the College's top academic award. With a total value of \$20,000, the \$5,000-per-year scholarship is renewable for up to three years, provided the student maintains a 3.25 GPA while attending full-time and making satisfactory progress towards graduation.

An invitation is required to apply for this scholarship. Qualified candidates are contacted by Macon State during their senior year of high school. To be considered, students must have a high school GPA of at least 3.50; a combined SAT score of 1200+ or equivalent ACT score of 26+; and currently be accepted for enrollment as a first-time, **full-time** freshman pursuing a bachelor's degree at Macon State.

Two scholarship reference forms are required for each applicant. Both references must be from educational professionals who are aware of the applicant's academic achievement and potential and are not members of the applicant's family. Applicants are responsible for ensuring completed reference forms are returned by the deadline.
