

Residence Life Appeal Process

Students who apply for campus housing and who are denied may appeal the decision of denial as follows:

The student must submit a written request for appeal of the denial of campus housing. In the appeal, the student must state the factors that he/she believes should have a positive impact on a housing decision.

Appeals must include the following information:

- Name
- 9-digit ID number or SSN
- PO Box number / Current mailing address
- Narrative explaining the rationale for why you are requesting to be exempt from the housing requirement. If no explanation is included, the appeal will be considered incomplete and returned to you.

If your appeal is to live with your immediate family or a spouse, please include:

- The mailing address for the location at which you will be residing;
- The name of the parent/guardian with whom you are living OR a copy of the marriage certificate;
- A letter supporting the request from your parent/guardian.

Steps in Appeal Process

1. Student submits appeal to:

2. Appeal is reviewed by the Residence Life Appeals Committee.
3. Student is notified of results of the appeal within 14 days of receipt of the application.
