Constitution

Article 1 Name and Purpose

A. The name of this organization is Dynamic Expressions. The purpose of the organization is to foster a culture of creativity among the MSC students.

B. The organization will support the mission of the Office of Student Life and the College. The organization will subscribe to the policies and procedures according to the University System of Georgia and Macon State College.

Article II Membership

A. Active membership is confined to regularly enrolled Macon State College students who have a minimum academic load of three (3) hours during each semester of participation.

B. Membership will not be denied because of race, national origin, color, sex, age, religion, or disability.

Article III Officers

A. Officers in this organization are as follows:

- 1) Co-Presidents: Drew Williams and Marquez Balkcom
- 2) Vice President: Andre Lee
- 3) Secretary: Tishka Davis
- 4) Treasurer: Ashley King

B. The duties for each officer are as follows:

- 1) Co-Presidents manage all meetings and assist with the coordination of each event. The presidents manage the facebook page according to the needs of the advisors.
- 2) The Vice President monitors students actions at each meeting to assist the presidents, directs questions to the president, and directs verbal traffic in the meetings. He may also assist the secretary with tracking notes during the meetings.
- 3) The Secretary takes minutes and/or writes down key ideas on the board during the meeting.
- 4) The Treasurer tracks expenses and manages budget-related paperwork.

C. All students holding an elected or appointed position of leadership and acting as an officer of this organization must hold a 2.0 cumulative grade point average and must be enrolled at MSC during the length of service to Dynamic Expressions.

Article IV Meetings

- A. This organization shall meet regularly during the fall and spring semesters. Meetings during the summer will be held as needed.
- B. All meetings, including the dates and times and locations will be confirmed with the Office of Student Life prior to publication and/or announcement of these meetings.

Article V Faculty Advisors

- A. The following advisors guide the organization: Karmen Lenz, Loretta Clayton, Sydney Chalfa
- B. The advisors approve all activities in advance by signing off on a formal "event proposal." The advisors approve any cancellations of events or reschedules.

Article VI Revenue

- A. All monies collected from membership dues and from all fundraisers must be deposited into the organization's MSC dues account. The deposits will be made through the MSC Business Office as soon as possible after the monies have been collected.
- B. No petty cash or slush funds will be kept by any member or advisor of this organization.
- C. All fundraisers will be approved by the Office of Student Life at least two weeks prior to the actual event and will follow the guidelines as outlined by the RSO recognition process.

Article VII Ratification

- A. This constitution is subject to approval by the proposed student membership, the Macon State College Student Government Association, the Office of Student Life, and the Dean of Students.

Article VIII By-Laws

- A. This constitution may be supplemented with By-Laws which pertain to the above articles.
- B. An electronic and paper copy of the By-laws will be filed with the Office of Student Life.

Article IX

- A. A written notice will be presented to the membership of this organization at a regular meeting to amend or supplement any part of this constitution. The proposed changes will be voted upon no sooner than the next regularly scheduled meeting and must receive two-thirds majority vote of all members in good standing.
- B. Any changes to this constitution will then be submitted to the Office of Student Life for approval.
