**Organization Constitution ARTICLE I**

**NAME AND PURPOSE**

- A. The name of this student organization shall be the “Powers N Numbers” and the purpose of this organization is to create a network between mathematics and science faculty and students in the organization, to illustrate and highlight career opportunities for mathematicians, to enhance each member’s knowledge and understanding of mathematics, and to promote unity and create a community for students interested in mathematics.
- B. This organization will support the mission of the Office of Student Life and Macon State College and will subscribe to the policies and procedures of the University System of Georgia and Macon State College.

**ARTICLE II**

**MEMBERSHIP**

- A. Active membership is confined to regularly enrolled Macon State College students who have a minimum academic load of three (3) hours during each semester of participation.
- B. Membership will not be denied because of race, national origin, color, sex, religion, or disability.

**ARTICLE III**

**OFFICERS**

- A. Officers of this organization will be:
  - a) President
  - b) Vice-President
  - c) Secretary
  - d) Treasurer
- B. The duties of each officer shall be:
  - a) Duties of the President shall be: to coordinate and conduct meetings; to work with the faculty advisor in leading and promoting the student organization on campus; to appoint interim officers if a position is vacated.
  - b) Duties of the Vice-President shall be: to assist the President in his/her duties including conducting meetings in the President’s absence; to assume the role of the President, should the position be vacated before the end of the academic year.
  - c) Duties of the Secretary shall be: to keep all members informed of up-coming club events and meetings; to keep attendance at meetings;

- to update the club roster.
- d) Duties of the Treasurer: to coordinate fund-raising and to manage the club's funds; to collect club dues and deposit them into the MSC Business Office as soon as possible
